In today's liturgy we face quite a contrast of experiences and emotions. As we gathered outside the Church today, we saw Jesus treated as He should have been. People were excited to see Him and there was great celebration at His presence.

But this excitement quickly turned to shock and horror as we enter more deeply into the readings. The Gospel of Luke ends with Jesus hanging on the Cross crying out "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit".?" "and when he had said this he breathed his last."

How could the people who were shouting and praising Him as He entered into Jerusalem abandon Him and allow Him to be crucified just a short time later? I guess you could say the simplest answer might be that the Father willed it. I think this is an important concept to understand.

At any time during that first Holy Week Jesus could have exercised His divine power and refused to embrace His Cross. But He didn't. He embraced this week willingly, choosing it as His own will.

Let this week give us all divine hope. Nothing can steal away our joy unless we let it. No hardship, no burden, and no cross can conquer us if we remain steadfast in Jesus letting Him transform all we endure in life by His glorious embrace of His own Cross.

Prayer: Lord, when I am tempted to despair, give me hope. Help me to see your presence in all things, even in those things that are most troubling to me. May this Holy Week transform my darkest moments and weakness as I surrender all to You, my God. Jesus, I trust in You.

#### Laura del Carmen Vicuña was born on April 5, 1891,

in <u>Santiago</u>, <u>Chile</u>, to José Domingo Vicuña and Mercedes Pino. The Vicuña family were Chilean aristocrats, the father in military service and the mother working at home. Forced out of Santiago by the revolution, the family took refuge in Temuco, but soon after José Domingo died suddenly and Mercedes went to live with her two daughters in Argentina. She was a child who was noted for her religious devotion. She was <u>beatified</u> by Pope John Paul II in 1988 as the



patron of abuse victims, having herself experienced physical abuse. The primary shrine for Laura Vicuña is located at Renca Hill, a park of 30 hectares lying between the communes of Quilicura and Renca in Santiago, Chile. The chapel has a capacity of 100. On December 9, 1999 a shrine in the city of Junin de los Andes was inaugurated and dedicated to her memory.
