Maria Troncatti, FMA (16 February 1883 - 25 August 1969) was

an <u>Italian Catholic</u> member of the <u>Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco</u>.

1 Troncatti was from a farming family and entered that congregation in

Capta Maria

1907; she worked as a nurse during World War I and became part of the missions in Ecuador from 1922 until her death in a plane crash in 1969. Troncatti was beatified on 24 November 2012 and will be canonized on 19 October 2025.

Troncatti joined the Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco on 15 October 1905 after having commenced her period of the <u>novitiate</u> and she later professed her vows on 17 1908 in <u>Nizza Monferrato</u>. Her father fainted as she left due to the pain of separation. She spent this time in <u>Varazze</u> in <u>Liguria</u>. Troncatti suffered a serious infection in 1909 and later contracted typhoid; this prompt-

ed a visit from Michele Rua who blessed her. In 1915 she passed a special course in nursing and used this education during World War I as she tended to ill and wounded soldiers - she also worked for the Red Cross while stationed in Varazze.
