Dear People of God,

In today's gospel Jesus gives us a complete summary of the moral law found in the Ten Commandments. The first three Commandments reveal that we must love God above all and with all our might. The last six Commandments reveal that we must love our neighbor. The moral law of God is as simple as fulfilling these two more general commandments.

Reflect today upon the simple call to love God and our neighbor with all that we are. Reflect, especially, upon that word "all". As we do, we will most certainly become aware of ways in which we fail to give everything. As we see our failure, recommit in hope to the glorious path of making a total gift of yourself to God and others.

Prayer: Lord, I choose to love you with all my heart, mind, soul and strength. I also choose to love all people as You love them. Give me the grace to live these two commandments of love and to see them as the path to holiness of life. Help me to love You more. Jesus, I trust in You.

### WHO IS DON BOSCO

[John Melchior Bosco, SDB, popularly known as Don Bosco, was an Italian Catholic priest, educator, writer and saint of the 19th century. While working in Turin, where the population suffered many of the ill-effects of industrialization and urbanization, he dedicated his life to the betterment and education of street children, juvenile delinquents, and other disadvantaged youth. He developed teaching methods based on love rather than punishment, a method that became known as the Salesian Preventive System.](#)


