There are four criteria that make a Salesian house and work truly Salesian. Every work must have all four of these criteria if they are to qualify as a successful and efficacious Salesian work: All work must be (1) homes that welcome (2) parishes that evangelize (3) schools that prepare for life, and (4) playgrounds where friends could meet and enjoy themselves.

Don Bosco wanted everyone to feel at home in his establishments. Family Spirit should be a recognizable element in every work. The Salesian house becomes a family when affection is mutual and when everyone feels welcome and responsible for the good of all.

In an atmosphere of mutual trust and daily forgiveness, the need and joy of sharing everything is experienced. . . . and relationships are governed not by rules and regulations , but by faith and the promptings of the heart. This is the witness and experience that fills and fires one to get to know and to follow the Salesian was.

This is the witness and experience that all of us here at MHC are invited to participate in. This is the witness and experience that we cannot afford to cheat ourselves from taking advantage of. This is the witness and experience that enables and empowers us to celebrate the Gospel courageously day after day. Happy and blessed Feast day to one and all! May we all come to know and love Don Bosco as I have been able to do over the years.

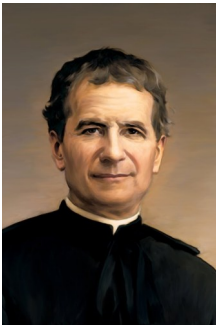

John Melchior Bosco, ([Italian](#): Giovanni Melchiorre Bosco; [Piedmontese](#): Gioann Melchior Bòsch; 16 August 1815 – 31 January 1888), popularly known as **Don Bosco** (was an [Italian Catholic](#) priest, educator and writer. While working in [Turin](#), where the population suffered many of the ill effects of [industrialization](#) and [urbanization](#), he dedicated his life to the betterment and education of [street children](#), [juvenile delinquents](#), and other disadvantaged youth. He developed teaching methods based on love rather than punishment, a method that became known as the [Salesian Preventive System](#). A follower of the spirituality and philosophy of [Francis de Sales](#), Bosco was an ardent devotee of the [Virgin Mary](#) under the title [Mary Help of Christians](#). He later dedicated his works to de Sales when he founded the [Salesians of Don Bosco](#), based in Turin. Together with [Maria Domenica Mazzarello](#), he founded the [Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians](#), now commonly known as the Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco, a religious congregation of nuns dedicated to the care and education of poor girls.
