María Romero Meneses, FMA (13 January 1902 – 7 July 1977) was a <u>Nicaraguan Catholic religious sister</u> and a professed member from the <u>Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco</u> dubbed the "Social Apostle of Costa Rica". María Romero Meneses was born in <u>Nicaragua</u> in 1902 as one of eight children to middle-class parents – her father was a government minister. Her parents were Félix Romero Arana and Ana Meneses Blandón. Her <u>baptism</u> was held on January the

> 20th. She received her <u>Confirmation</u> on July 23, 1904, from Siméon Pereira y Castellón and received her <u>First Communion</u> on December 8, 1909. The hopeful girl joined the Marian association <u>Daughters of Mary Help of Chris-</u> <u>tians</u> on December 8, 1915, to follow her Marian call. In 1920 she joined that congregation and left for <u>El Salvador</u> for her period of <u>novitiate</u>, receiving the habit of the order on January 16, 1921. On 6 January 1929 in Nicaragua she made her final profession.
