A bishop was examining the candidates for Confirmation at a certain parish. He asked the young people to tell him what the Holy Trinity was. A boy answered: “It’s one-in-three, and three-in-one.” The bishop, gently probing to determine if the boy truly prepared for the sacrament, said: “That’s good, but I don’t understand.” The boy immediately responded:” You’re not supposed to!”

I remember my first homily as a priest which was on the Holy Trinity. I was filled with the ardor of my ordination just a few days before. I wrote pages and pages determined to make clear once and for all this most mysterious of all mysteries to the poor people of St. Matthew’s Church in Gahanna, Ohio who were doomed to have to listen to those words. St. Matthew’s was where I had just completed four years of ministerial service and was offering my first solo mass. My parents were in attendance and my Father, after suffering through almost 40 minutes of this, finally raised his handkerchief as a sign of surrender. Needless to say, I put an end to the collective suffering as quickly as I could.

We might never grasp the how of the Holy Trinity, but we can know the Who. The Holy Spirit reveals the Father and the Son to us and gives us the gift of faith to know and understand the truth of God’s word. This is because God continually reveals Himself to us. If we ever find ourselves confused or in doubt as to any discussion on Trinitarian love, we can respond as did Moses, bowing low to the ground in worship. Rejoice exultantly with the saints and angels praising God “in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit”.



Leonardo Murialdo, CSI (26 October 1828 – 30 March 1900) was an [Italian Catholic](#) priest and the co-founder of the Congregation of Saint Joseph - also known as the Murialdines (which he founded alongside [Eugenio Reffo](#)). Murialdo's call to the priesthood did not manifest until late in his education in [Savona](#); he pursued his ecclesial studies and was [ordained](#) as such in 1851 before dedicating himself to social work alongside the poor and with adolescent men. This put him into contact with other priests of the era such as [Giovanni Bosco](#) and [Giuseppe Cafasso](#) who held Murialdo in great esteem. His zeal for social concern saw his frequent calls for an end to worker exploitation and the granting of further rights to workers in factories. Murialdo died in the [odour of holiness](#) in 1900 and had a reputation for deep personal holiness. This became more prevalent in northern Italian cities where Murialdo and his religious order worked. The cause for his canonization opened under [Pope Benedict XV](#) in 1921 with [Pope John XXIII](#) later confirming his [heroic virtue](#) and naming Murialdo as Venerable in 1961. [Pope Paul VI](#) beatified Murialdo in late 1963 and later canonized him just under a decade later in 1970.

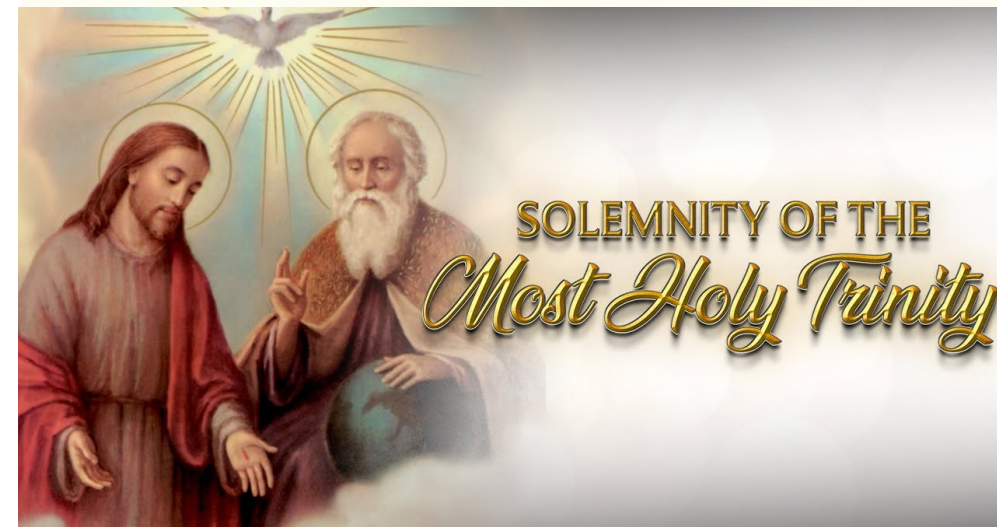
